

## Falling Rock Park

Falling Rock Park is a former rock quarry located just outside of La Grange, Kentucky, in Oldham County. It is owned by the Clark family and has been turned into a dive site. The water is very clean for a quarry with visibility generally around 20+ feet. Water temperature in summer varies from 72+/- degrees in the top 15 to 20 feet to 50 +/- degrees at 44 feet. There is a thermocline around 15 to 20 feet with an immediate 15 degree water temperature drop. There is a second thermocline between 25 to 35 feet deep with an additional temperature drop. The quarry is home to several varieties of fish, including bass, bluegill, and catfish.

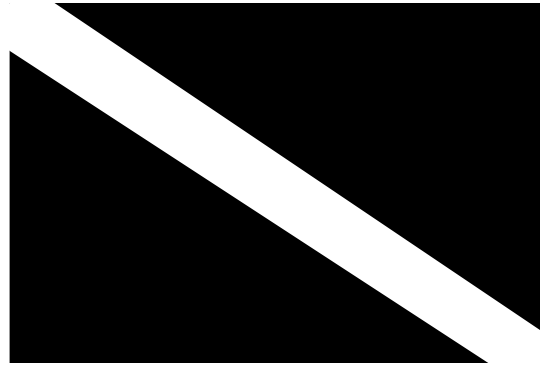

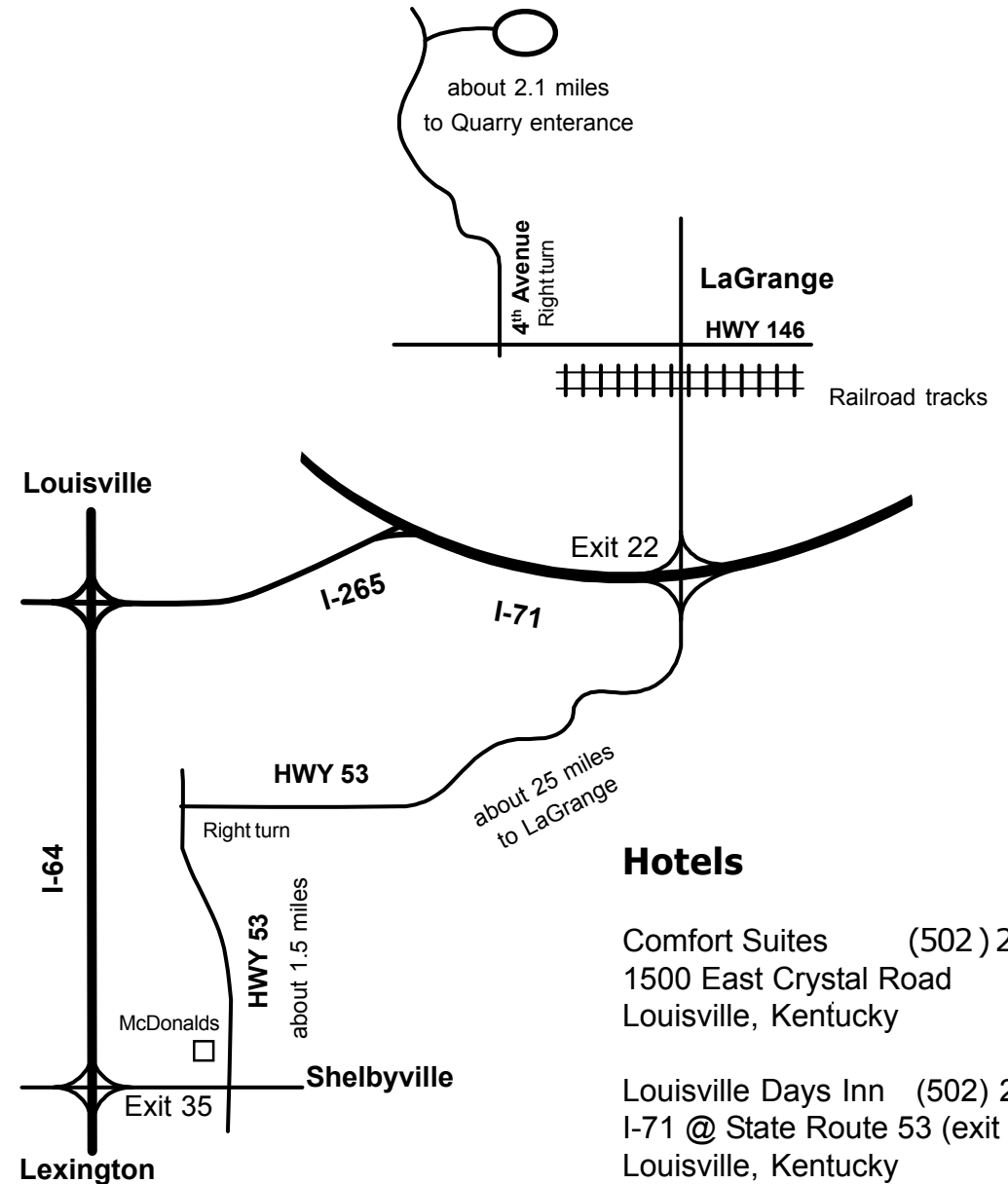

## Directions from Lexington

- Take I-64 West to Shelbyville exit 35 and turn right towards town.
- Take a left onto State Rd 53 and follow it North thru Shelbyville for 25 miles to La Grange.
- Follow 53 thru town and turn left at the first street after the railroad tracks. (Hwy 146)
- Turn right on 4th street and follow it for about 2.1 miles.
- After you cross a small bridge Falling Rock Park is the second road on your right.

All divers must have Open Water certification from a reputable training agency or be a student under the supervision of an instructor.

All divers must be physically fit to dive.

All divers shall not be in the possession or under the influence of any illegal drugs.

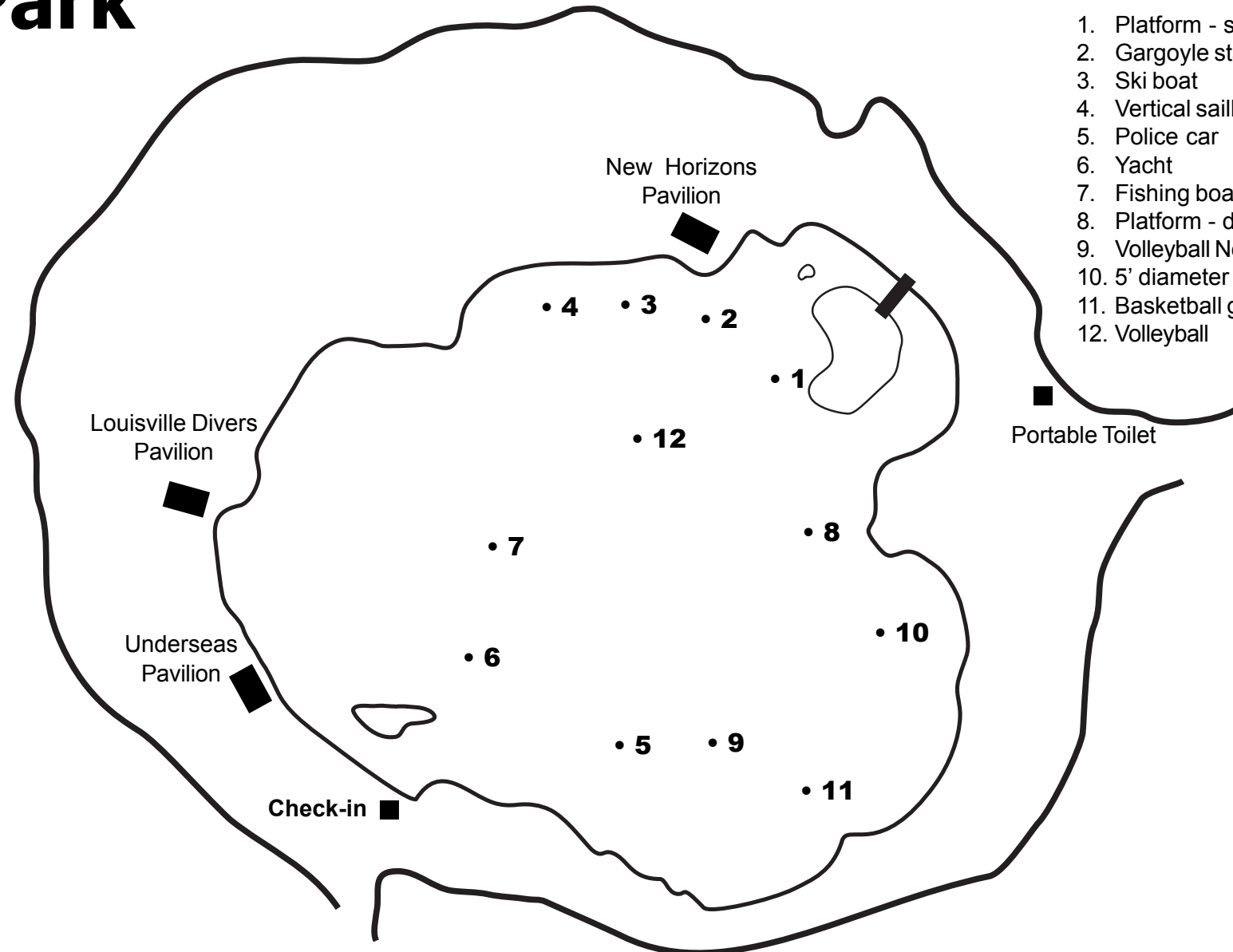
All divers are required to dive in buddy teams at all times.

All divers must return from a dive with 500 psi remaining.

No one under 18 years of age is allowed to dive with out direct supervision of an instructor.
